has a developmental disability, the department shall issue an identification card exhibiting a capital "D" for the person, child, or ward if the person or the parent or guardian of the child or ward submits: a. Payment of an additional \$10 fee; and b. Proof acceptable to the department of a diagnosis by a licensed physician of a developmental disability as defined in s. 393.063. 2. The department shall deposit the additional \$10 fee into the Agency for Persons with Disabilities Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund under s. 20.1971(2). 3. A replacement identification card that includes the designation may be issued without payment of the fee required under s. 322.21(1)(f). 4. The department shall develop rules to facilitate the issuance, requirements, and oversight of developmental disability identification cards under this section. Section 2. The amendments made by this act to s. 322.051, Florida Statutes, shall apply upon implementation of new designs for the driver license and identification card by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles. Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
