7 5. A restricted distributor permit is not required for
 8 distributions between pharmacies that each hold an active permit
 9 under chapter 465, have a common ownership, and are operating in
 10 a freestanding end-stage renal dialysis clinic, if such a
 11 distribution is made to meet the immediate emergency medical
 12 needs of specifically identified patients and does not occur
 13 with such frequency as to amount to the regular and systematic
 14 supplying of that drug between the pharmacies. The department
 15 shall develop rules establishing when the distribution of a
 16 prescription drug under this paragraph amounts to the regular
 17 and systematic supplying of that drug.
