20	other attendant circumstances so as not to endanger the life,
21	limb, or property of <u>another</u> any person <u>outside the vessel or</u>
22	endanger the life, limb, or property of any person due to vessel
23	overloading or excessive speed. The failure to operate a vessel
24	in a manner described in this subsection constitutes careless
25	operation. However, vessel wake and shoreline wash resulting
26	from the reasonable and prudent operation of a vessel shall,
27	absent negligence, <u>does</u> not constitute damage or endangerment to
