

27 living expenses shall be covered under the program.

28 (4) From funds appropriated for the program, the
29 department may make a loan payment of up to \$16,000 on behalf of
30 selected candidates who complete 8 years of consecutive
31 employment as a teacher of STEM courses at a public school in
32 the state. All payments are contingent upon proof of completion
33 of program requirements and shall be made directly to the holder
34 of the loan.

35 (5) The department may recover from funds appropriated for
36 the program the costs of administering the program.

37 (6) The State Board of Education may adopt rules necessary
38 to administer the program.

39 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
