An act relating to the protection of veterans; creating s. 295.24, F.S.; prohibiting an agent or attorney retained for purposes of a veteran's claims assistance from seeking reimbursement for a specified

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Section 295.24, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
- 295.24 Agents or attorneys retained for veterans' claims assistance; prohibition; penalty.—
- (1) A person who is recognized as an agent or attorney by the United States Secretary of Veterans Affairs for purposes of preparing, presenting, and prosecuting claims under laws administered by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs and is charged an assessment pursuant to 38 U.S.C. s.

  5904(a)(6)(A) may not, directly or indirectly, request, receive, or obtain reimbursement for such assessment from the claimant he or she represents.
- (2) A person who violates this section commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
