15 (a) At a statewide state-wide general election in each 16 calendar year the number of which is even and but not a multiple 17 of four, the electors shall choose a governor and a lieutenant governor and members of the cabinet each for a term of four 18 19 years beginning on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in 20 January of the succeeding year. In primary elections, candidates 21 for the office of governor may choose to run without a 22 lieutenant governor candidate. In the general election, all candidates for the offices of governor and lieutenant governor 23 24 shall form joint candidacies in a manner prescribed by law so 25 that each voter shall cast a single vote for a candidate for 26 governor and a candidate for lieutenant governor running 27 together.

28 When elected, the governor, lieutenant governor and (b) 29 each cabinet member must be an elector not less than thirty years of age who has resided in the state for the preceding 30 31 seven years. The attorney general must have been a member of the 32 bar of Florida for the preceding five years. No person who has, or but for resignation would have, served as governor or acting 33 34 governor for more than six years in two consecutive terms shall 35 be elected governor for the succeeding term.
