Space Exploration Laboratory.....	50,000

Funds provided in Specific Appropriation 68 for Space Exploration Laboratory shall be used to establish a research laboratory in support of a space exploration laboratory at a Florida research university. These funds shall be used for construction of laboratory space and acquisition of research equipment. These funds shall be awarded on a competitive basis to a Florida-based public or private research university. A university applying for these funds shall be required to provide a dollar-for-dollar match from private sources, and commit to the on-going maintenance and operation of the laboratory using private funds. A task force shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate for the purpose of soliciting proposals from Florida research universities and selecting the proposal which will be funded by the Florida Department of Education. The Speaker of the Florida House of Representatives shall appoint three members to the task force for a one year term. The President of the Florida Senate shall appoint three members to the task force for a one year term. The task force shall elect from its membership one member to serve as chair of the task force and one member to serve as vice chair. A majority of the members of the task force shall constitute a quorum. The task force may conduct its meetings through teleconferences or other similar means. The Florida Department of Education shall provide such staff, information, and other assistance as is reasonably necessary to assist the task force in carrying out its responsibilities.
