Immediately following Specific Appropriation 218, INSERT:

The Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) may, pursuant to section 409.912, Florida Statutes, contract with a provider service network, as defined in section 409.962, Florida Statutes, that is a specialty plan for medically complex and medically fragile children who are eligible to voluntarily enroll in the Medicaid Managed Medical Assistance program pursuant to section 409.972, Florida Statutes, through either a fee-for-service or capitated payment arrangement. AHCA shall plan to transition the project into the Medicaid Managed Medical Assistance program under part IV of chapter 409 during the next round of procurement under that part.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
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
