4 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

5 Section 1. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 1010.04,

6 Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

7 1010.04 Purchasing.—

8 (1) (a) Purchases and leases by school districts and
9 Florida College System institutions shall comply with the
10 requirements of law and rules of the State Board of Education.

11 (b) Before purchasing nonacademic commodities and
12 contractual services, each district school board and Florida
13 College System institution board of trustees shall review the
14 purchasing agreements and state term contracts available under

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15 s. 287.056 to determine whether it is in the school board's or
 16 the board of trustees' economic advantage to use the agreements
 17 and contracts. Each bid specification for nonacademic
 18 commodities and contractual services must include a statement
 19 indicating that the purchasing agreements and state term
 20 contracts available under s. 287.056 have been reviewed. Each
 21 district school board may also use the cooperative state
 22 purchasing programs managed through the regional consortium
 23 service organizations pursuant to their authority under s.
 24 1001.451(3). This paragraph does not apply to services that are
 25 eligible for reimbursement under the federal E-rate program
 26 administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company.

27 (c) ~~(b)~~ Purchases and leases by state universities shall
 28 comply with the requirements of law and regulations of the Board
 29 of Governors.

30 (2) Each district school board and Florida College System
 31 institution board of trustees shall adopt rules, and each
 32 university board of trustees shall adopt regulations, to be
 33 followed in making purchases. Purchases may be made through an
 34 online procurement system, an electronic auction service, or
 35 other efficient procurement tool.

36 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
