6 (2) ADOPTION OF BYLAWS, POLICIES, OR GUIDELINES.—

7 (c) The FHSAA shall adopt bylaws that require all students  
 8 participating in interscholastic athletic competition or who are  
 9 candidates for an interscholastic athletic team to  
 10 satisfactorily pass a medical evaluation each year prior to  
 11 participating in interscholastic athletic competition or  
 12 engaging in any practice, tryout, workout, or other physical  
 13 activity associated with the student's candidacy for an  
 14 interscholastic athletic team. Such medical evaluation may be  
 15 administered only by a practitioner licensed under chapter 458,  
 16 chapter 459, chapter 460, or s. 464.012, and in good standing  
 17 with the practitioner's regulatory board. The bylaws shall

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18 establish requirements for eliciting a student's medical history  
19 and performing the medical evaluation required under this  
20 paragraph, which shall include a physical assessment of the  
21 student's physical capabilities to participate in  
22 interscholastic athletic competition as contained in a uniform  
23 preparticipation physical evaluation and history form. The  
24 evaluation form shall incorporate the recommendations of the  
25 American Heart Association for participation cardiovascular  
26 screening and shall provide a place for the signature of the  
27 practitioner performing the evaluation with an attestation that  
28 each examination procedure listed on the form was performed by  
29 the practitioner or by someone under the direct supervision of  
30 the practitioner. The form shall also contain a place for the  
31 practitioner to indicate if a referral to another practitioner  
32 was made in lieu of completion of a certain examination  
33 procedure. The form shall provide a place for the practitioner  
34 to whom the student was referred to complete the remaining  
35 sections and attest to that portion of the examination. The  
36 preparticipation physical evaluation form shall contain  
37 information that advises a student ~~advise students~~ to complete a  
38 cardiovascular assessment that includes an electrocardiogram.  
39 The preparticipation physical evaluation form ~~and~~ shall also  
40 include information concerning alternative cardiovascular  
41 evaluation and diagnostic tests. Results of such medical  
42 evaluation must be provided to the school. No student shall be  
43 eligible to participate in any interscholastic athletic

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44 competition or engage in any practice, tryout, workout, or other  
45 physical activity associated with the student's candidacy for an  
46 interscholastic athletic team until the results of the medical  
47 evaluation have been received and approved by the school. The  
48 FHSAA shall make available to the parent of each student  
49 literature on the importance of a preparticipation  
50 cardiovascular assessment that includes an electrocardiogram.
