7 Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 382.011, Florida
 8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 382.011 Medical examiner determination of cause of death.—

10 (1) In the case of any death or fetal death involving the
 11 circumstances ~~due to causes or conditions~~ listed in s. 406.11(1)
 12 ~~406.11~~, any death that occurred more than 12 months after the
 13 decedent was last treated by a primary or attending physician as
 14 defined in s. 382.008(3), or any death for which there is reason
 15 to believe that the death may have been due to an unlawful act
 16 or neglect, the funeral director or other person to whose

17 attention the death may come shall refer the case to the
18 district medical examiner of the county in which the death.

19 Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 406.06, Florida
20 Statutes, is amended to read:

21 406.06 District medical examiners; associates; suspension
22 of medical examiners.—

23 (3) District medical examiners and associate medical
24 examiners shall be entitled to compensation and such reasonable
25 salary and fees as are established by the board of county
26 commissioners in the respective districts. However, a medical
27 examiner or a county may not charge a member of the public a fee
28 for an examination, investigation, or autopsy performed pursuant
29 to s. 406.11.
