12 governmental contractor for volunteer, uncompensated services  
13 which allows the health care provider to deliver health care  
14 services to low-income recipients as an agent of the

16 ~~uncompensated services, except as provided in paragraph (4)(g).~~  
17 For services to qualify as volunteer, uncompensated services  
18 under this section, the health care provider, or any employee or  
19 agent of the health care provider, must receive no compensation  
20 from the governmental contractor for any services provided under  
21 the contract and must not bill or accept compensation from the  
22 recipient, or a public or private third-party payor, for the  
23 specific services provided to the low-income recipients covered  
24 by the contract, except as provided in paragraph (4)(g). A free  
25 clinic as described in subparagraph (d)14. may receive a  
26 legislative appropriation, a grant through a legislative  
27 appropriation, or a grant from a governmental entity or  
28 nonprofit corporation to support the delivery of contracted  
29 services by volunteer health care providers, including the  
30 employment of health care providers to supplement, coordinate,  
31 or support the delivery of such services. The appropriation or  
32 grant for the free clinic does not constitute compensation under  
33 this paragraph from the governmental contractor for services  
34 provided under the contract, nor does receipt or use of the  
35 appropriation or grant constitute the acceptance of compensation  
36 under this paragraph for the specific services provided to the  
37 low-income recipients covered by the contract.
