> Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 381.986, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

381.986 Compassionate use of low-THC cannabis.-

- (6) DISPENSING ORGANIZATION. -
- (a) An approved dispensing organization shall maintain compliance with the criteria demonstrated for selection and approval as a dispensing organization under subsection (5) at



all times. Before dispensing low-THC cannabis to a qualified patient, the dispensing organization shall verify that the patient has an active registration in the compassionate use registry, the order presented matches the order contents as recorded in the registry, and the order has not already been filled. Upon dispensing the low-THC cannabis, the dispensing organization shall record in the registry the date, time, quantity, and form of low-THC cannabis dispensed.

(b) The dispensing organization shall retain an independent testing laboratory to test the low-THC cannabis for microbials, mold, pesticides, fertilizers, harmful chemicals, and toxins. For purposes of this paragraph, the term "independent testing laboratory" means a laboratory, and the managers, employees, and contractors of the laboratory, which does not have a direct or indirect interest in, and is not owned by or affiliated with, a dispensing organization.
