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10 11 (e) A dispensing organization as defined in s. 381.986 must test cannabis before it is sold or distributed to an eligible patient or the eligible patient's legal representative. Testing of the cannabis must be performed by an independent testing laboratory. For purposes of this paragraph, the term "independent testing laboratory" means a laboratory, including the managers, employees, or contractors of the laboratory, which Florida Senate - 2016 Bill No. SB 460

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12	has no direct or indirect interest in a dispensing organization.
13	Results must be verified and signed by two dispensing
14	organization employees. Before dispensing the cannabis, the
15	dispensing organization must determine that the test results
16	indicate that it is safe for human consumption and free from
17	contaminants that are unsafe for human consumption. The
18	independent testing laboratory must also test the cannabis for
19	microbials, mold, pesticides, fertilizers, harmful chemicals,
20	and toxins and the dispensing organization must make a
21	determination that test results indicate that any presence of
22	such substances in the cannabis is safe for human consumption
23	before dispensing the cannabis.
