DELETE the proviso in Specific Appropriation 466:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 466, \$2,100,000 of which \$1,800,000 is nonrecurring from the General Revenue Fund is provided to the Mary Brogan Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program.

AND INSERT:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 466, \$7,100,000 of which \$6,800,000 is nonrecurring from the General Revenue Fund is provided to the Mary Brogan Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
