3 **Amendment (with title amendment)**

4 Remove lines 33-90 and insert:

5 2. The applicant's address of legal residence, including a  
6 distinguishing apartment, suite, lot, room, or dormitory room  
7 number or other identifier, if appropriate address. Failure to  
8 include a distinguishing apartment, suite, lot, room, or  
9 dormitory room or other identifier on a voter registration  
10 application does not impact a voter's eligibility to register to  
11 vote or cast a ballot, and such an omission may not serve as the  
12 basis for a challenge to a voter's eligibility or reason to not  
13 count a ballot.

14 3. The applicant's date of birth.

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15 4. A mark in the checkbox affirming that the applicant is  
16 a citizen of the United States.

17 5.a. The applicant's current and valid Florida driver  
18 license number or the identification number from a Florida  
19 identification card issued under s. 322.051, or

20 b. If the applicant has not been issued a current and  
21 valid Florida driver license or a Florida identification card,  
22 the last four digits of the applicant's social security number.

23  
24 In case an applicant has not been issued a current and valid  
25 Florida driver license, Florida identification card, or social  
26 security number, the applicant shall affirm this fact in the  
27 manner prescribed in the uniform statewide voter registration  
28 application.

29 6. A mark in the checkbox affirming that the applicant has  
30 not been convicted of a felony or that, if convicted, has had  
31 his or her civil rights restored.

32 7. A mark in the checkbox affirming that the applicant has  
33 not been adjudicated mentally incapacitated with respect to  
34 voting or that, if so adjudicated, has had his or her right to  
35 vote restored.

36 8. The original signature or a digital signature  
37 transmitted by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor  
38 Vehicles of the applicant swearing or affirming under the  
39 penalty for false swearing pursuant to s. 104.011 that the  
40 information contained in the registration application is true

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41 and subscribing to the oath required by s. 3, Art. VI of the  
42 State Constitution and s. 97.051.

43 Section 3. Subsection (10) of section 97.057, Florida  
44 Statutes, is amended to read:

45 97.057 Voter registration by the Department of Highway  
46 Safety and Motor Vehicles.—

47 (10) The department shall provide the Department of  
48 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles with an electronic database of  
49 street addresses valid for use as the address of legal residence  
50 ~~address~~ as required in s. 97.053(5). The Department of Highway  
51 Safety and Motor Vehicles shall compare the address provided by  
52 the applicant against the database of valid street addresses. If  
53 the address provided by the applicant does not match a valid  
54 street address in the database, the applicant will be asked to  
55 verify the address provided. The Department of Highway Safety  
56 and Motor Vehicles shall not reject any application for voter  
57 registration for which a valid match cannot be made.

58 Section 4. Subsection (12) of section 98.015, Florida  
59 Statutes, is amended to read:

60 98.015 Supervisor of elections; election, tenure of  
61 office, compensation, custody of registration-related documents,  
62 office hours, successor, seal; appointment of deputy  
63 supervisors; duties.—

64 (12) Each supervisor shall maintain a list of valid  
65 residential street addresses for purposes of verifying the legal  
66 addresses of voters residing in the supervisor's county. To the

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67 maximum extent practicable, the list shall include information  
68 necessary to differentiate one residence from another,  
69 including, but not limited to, a distinguishing apartment,  
70 suite, lot, room, or dormitory room number or other identifier.  
71 If a voter registration application does not include information  
72 necessary to differentiate one residence from another, the  
73 supervisor shall make all reasonable efforts to obtain such  
74 information in order to maintain the list of valid residential  
75 street addresses.
