Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 768.38, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

768.38 Liability arising out of drone use.—Notwithstanding s. 768.81, if a person suffers an injury or property damage caused by the negligent operation of a drone, the owner and operator of the drone are liable for damages on the basis of the doctrine of joint and several liability. As used in this section, the term "drone" has the same meaning as in s. 934.50.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
