18 Such devices shall be integrated with the public lodging
19 establishment's fire detection system. Any such installation ~~or~~
20 ~~determination~~ shall be made in accordance with rules adopted by
21 the Division of State Fire Marshall. In lieu of connecting the
22 carbon monoxide detector to the fire detection system described
23 above, the connector may be connected to a control unit listed
24 as complying with UL 2017 or a combination system in accordance
25 with NFPA 720. Either the control unit or the combination system
26 shall be connected to the boiler safety circuit such that the
27 boiler is prevented from operating when carbon monoxide is
28 detected until it is reset manually.
