10 authorizing a bona fide nonprofit civic organization, charitable
11 organization, municipality, or county to sell alcoholic
12 beverages for consumption on the premises only, for a period not
13 to exceed 3 days, subject to any state law or municipal or
14 county ordinance regulating the time for selling such beverages.

 20 must be donated to a nonprofit civic or charitable organization
