5 Between lines 168 and 169, insert:

6 (5) Each Florida College System institution and state  
 7 university board of trustees is authorized to adopt policies  
 8 that allow for the use of innovative pricing techniques and  
 9 payment options for digital textbooks and instructional  
 10 materials. Such policies may include bulk pricing arrangements  
 11 that enable students to purchase integrated course materials and  
 12 texts delivered digitally or through other technologies that  
 13 are, or the licenses of which are, required for use within a  
 14 course. Innovative pricing techniques and payment options must  
 15 include an opt out provision for students and may be approved  
 16 only if there is documented evidence that the options reduce the  
 17 cost of textbooks and instructional materials for students.
