Amendment to Amendment (665868) (with title amendment)

Between lines 176 and 177 of the amendment, insert:

Section 10. Notwithstanding any law or local ordinance to the contrary, nonemergency transportation services under any Medicaid program administered by the state or its contracted providers may be provided, subject only to Medicaid laws, rules, and contract terms, by entities, including, but not limited to, commercial airlines, ground ambulances subcontracted for use as stretcher vans, ground and air ambulances, mass transit and public transportation systems, medical vehicles (wheelchair or stretcher vans), multiload passenger vans, private vehicles, private nonprofit agencies, and taxis. A political subdivision

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15 may not limit or proscribe the types of vehicles that may be
16 used for nonemergency medical transportation covered by any
17 federally funded program or commercial health coverage product.
