4 Remove lines 5-16 of the amendment and insert:

5 Section 38. Active duty soldiers.-

6 (1) The tax levied under chapter 212, Florida Statutes,  
7 may not be collected during the period from 12:01 a.m. on July  
8 1, 2016, through 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2020, for retail  
9 purchases of tangible personal property made by a soldier on  
10 active duty, as defined in s. 250.01, for personal use.

11 (2) To be eligible for the tax exemption, the active duty  
12 soldier must provide identification verifying the active duty  
13 status.

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14       (3) The Department of Revenue may, and all conditions are  
15 deemed met to, adopt emergency rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1)  
16 and 120.54, Florida Statutes, to administer this section.
