14 (d) Fishing supplies. For purposes of this section, the
15 term "fishing supplies" means rods, reels, bait, and fishing
16 tackle. The term does not include supplies used for commercial
17 fishing purposes.

18 (2) Each purchaser is limited to one firearm as defined in
19 paragraph (1)(a) and 100 rounds of ammunition suitable for those
20 firearms, for purposes of the tax exemptions authorized in
21 paragraphs (1)(a) and (b).

22 (3) The tax exemptions provided in this section do not
23 apply to sales within a theme park or entertainment complex as
24 defined in s. 509.013(9), Florida Statutes, within a public
25 lodging establishment as defined in s. 509.013(4), Florida
26 Statutes, or within an airport as defined in s. 330.27(2),
27 Florida Statutes.
