7 Section 4. Paragraphs (c) and (e) of subsection (1) of  
8 section 704.06, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

9 704.06 Conservation easements; creation; acquisition;  
10 enforcement.—

11 (1) As used in this section, "conservation easement" means  
12 a right or interest in real property which is appropriate to  
13 retaining land or water areas predominantly in their natural,  
14 scenic, open, agricultural, or wooded condition; retaining such  
15 areas as suitable habitat for fish, plants, or wildlife;  
16 retaining the structural integrity or physical appearance of  
17 sites or properties of historical, architectural,

18 archaeological, or cultural significance; or maintaining  
19 existing land uses and which prohibits or limits any or all of  
20 the following:

21 (c) Removal or destruction of trees, shrubs, or other  
22 vegetation except when needed for maintenance purposes.

23 (e) Surface use except for purposes that permit the land  
24 or water area to remain predominantly in its natural or  
25 agricultural condition, which may include livestock grazing  
26 where such activity is a current or historic use of the land to  
27 be placed under the conservation easement and provided that  
28 future livestock grazing within the conservation easement area  
29 is conducted in accordance with applicable best management  
30 practices adopted by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer  
31 Services.
