15	(1) The following students are exempt from the payment of
16	tuition and fees, including lab fees, at a school district that
17	provides workforce education programs, Florida College System
18	institution, or state university:
19	(c) A student who is or was at the time he or she reached
20	18 years of age in the custody of the Department of Children and
21	Families or who, after spending at least 6 months in the custody
22	of the department after reaching 16 years of age, was placed in
23	a guardianship by the court. Such exemption includes fees
24	associated with enrollment in applied academics for adult
25	education instruction. The exemption remains valid until the
26	student reaches 28 years of age.
