7 (3) and (9) of section 1002.41, Florida Statutes, are amended,  
8 and subsections (10) through (14) are added to that section, to  
9 read:

10 1002.41 Home education programs.—

11 (1) A "home education program" is defined in s. 1002.01.  
12 The parent is not required to hold a valid regular Florida  
13 teaching certificate.

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14 (a) The parent shall notify the district school  
 15 superintendent of the county in which the parent resides of her  
 16 or his intent to establish and maintain a home education  
 17 program. The notice shall be in writing, signed by the parent,  
 18 and shall include the names, addresses, and birthdates of all  
 19 children who shall be enrolled as students in the home education  
 20 program. The notice shall be filed in the district school  
 21 superintendent's office within 30 days of the establishment of  
 22 the home education program. Enrollment in a home education  
 23 program is a ministerial act by the district school  
 24 superintendent upon receipt of the notice and may only be  
 25 terminated pursuant to subsection (2). A written notice of  
 26 termination of the home education program shall be filed in the  
 27 district school superintendent's office within 30 days after  
 28 said termination.
