1 House Resolution 2 A resolution recognizing January 26, 2016, as "Florida Gulf Coast University Day" in Florida. 3 4 5 WHEREAS, in May 1991, then-Governor Lawton Chiles signed 6 into law a bill passed by the Florida Legislature authorizing 7 the creation of Florida's tenth public university, Florida Gulf 8 Coast University (FGCU), to provide higher education opportunities and workforce development in the previously 9 10 underserved region of Southwest Florida, and WHEREAS, FGCU opened its doors to students on August 25, 11 12 1997, and held its first commencement in May 1998 with 81 13 graduates, and WHEREAS, FGCU has strategically grown into a regional 14 15 university of nearly 15,000 students and today offers 53 undergraduate, 24 graduate, 9 certificate, and 3 doctoral 16 17 programs, and WHEREAS, FGCU's top priority is student success, with five 18 19 colleges providing relevant programs with an accomplished 20 faculty, small classes, and extensive individualized attention 21 to help students prepare for successful careers and meet 22 regional and statewide workforce needs, and 23 WHEREAS, FGCU has achieved national prominence in 24 academics, environmental sustainability, and student service 25 learning, with nearly two million hours contributed to the 26 Southwest Florida community since 1997, and Page 1 of 4

27 WHEREAS, 400 acres of the FGCU campus are designated as 28 restored and preserved wetlands, and the university operates a 29 15-acre solar field that generates 85 percent of the electric 30 power for three academic buildings, saving \$700,000 in energy 31 costs annually, and

32 WHEREAS, FGCU emphasizes innovative and interdisciplinary 33 learning, using the region as a living laboratory while offering 34 students diverse opportunities to participate in meaningful 35 research led by their professors, who have conducted more than 36 \$194 million in research and sponsored programs since 1997, and

37 WHEREAS, FGCU has established the Institute of 38 Entrepreneurship, bringing engineering and business students 39 together to develop products and business plans in a real-world 40 setting, and later this year will open the Emergent Technologies 41 Institute to provide learning opportunities that will enhance 42 the university's science, technology, engineering, and 43 mathematics (STEM) education and sustainability initiatives, and

44 WHEREAS, FGCU has one of only 19 PGA-certified golf 45 management programs in the country and the largest certified 46 program in Florida, and

WHEREAS, FGCU is a leader in the State University System of this state, with 74 percent of alumni employed or continuing their education within one year after graduation, and

50 WHEREAS, FGCU focuses on college affordability for all 51 students by maintaining its commitment to cost containment, 52 holding tuition at the same level for three years, and
