House Resolution

A resolution recognizing June 2016 as "Scleroderma Awareness Month" in Florida.

5 WHEREAS, scleroderma, also known as systemic sclerosis, is 6 a chronic systemic autoimmune disease characterized by hardening 7 of the skin, increased synthesis of collagen, damage to small 8 blood vessels, and production of altered connective tissue, 9 sometimes also affecting internal organs, and

10 WHEREAS, the major causes of death in persons with 11 scleroderma are pulmonary hypertension, pulmonary fibrosis, and 12 scleroderma renal crisis, and

WHEREAS, an estimated 300,000 people in United States have scleroderma and the effects of scleroderma range from very mild to life threatening, and

16 WHEREAS, while there is no proven cure for scleroderma, 17 treatments are available that can prevent, minimize, or 18 alleviate its effects and may prolong the lives of individuals 19 with less severe cases of the disease, and

20 WHEREAS, collaborative medical research is an important 21 component in the development of improved therapies and an 22 eventual cure for scleroderma, and

23 WHEREAS, the increased awareness of the nature and scope of 24 scleroderma in the state will encourage support for families and 25 individuals suffering as a consequence of this disease, NOW, 26 THEREFORE,
