1 House Resolution 2 A resolution to raise awareness of stomach cancer. 3 4 WHEREAS, stomach cancer, also referred to as gastric 5 cancer, forms in tissues lining the stomach and typically 6 develops slowly over many years, and 7 WHEREAS, as of 2012, an estimated 76,829 people were living 8 with stomach cancer in the United States, and WHEREAS, the treatment for stomach cancer may include 9 10 surgery, radiation, chemotherapy, biologic therapy, or a 11 combination of these options, and 12 WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society reports that the overall 5-year relative survival rate of people with stomach 13 14 cancer in the United States is approximately 29 percent, and 15 WHEREAS, about 80 percent of individuals diagnosed with 16 stomach cancer are diagnosed with metastatic cancer, and 17 WHEREAS, late diagnosis of stomach cancer, which significantly reduces the 5-year survival rate, is often due to 18 19 the fact that stomach cancer has very few warning signs, and 20 WHEREAS, in 2015, an estimated 24,590 Americans learned that they have stomach cancer, and nearly 11,000 died from this 21 22 disease, NOW, THEREFORE, 23 24 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 25 Florida: 26
