9 prescription refill and the pharmacist is unable to readily  
10 obtain refill authorization from the prescriber, the pharmacist  
11 may dispense:

12 (a) A one-time emergency refill of up to a 144-hour ~~72-~~  
13 ~~hour~~ supply of the prescribed medication; or

14 (b) A one-time emergency refill of up to a 30-day supply  
15 of an antidiabetic medication to treat type 1 diabetes mellitus.

16 (2) If the Governor issues, ~~with the exception of these~~

18 ~~of a state of emergency declared by the Governor, in which the~~  
19 ~~executive order may authorize the pharmacist~~ may ~~to~~ dispense up  
20 to a 30-day supply in the areas or counties affected by the  
21 order or proclamation, provided ~~providing~~ that:

22 (a) ~~(1)~~ The prescription is not for a medicinal drug listed  
23 in Schedule II appearing in chapter 893.

24 (b) ~~(2)~~ The medication is essential to the maintenance of  
25 life or to the continuation of therapy in a chronic condition.

26 (c) ~~(3)~~ In the pharmacist's professional judgment, the  
27 interruption of therapy might reasonably produce undesirable  
28 health consequences or may cause physical or mental discomfort.

29 (d) ~~(4)~~ The dispensing pharmacist creates a written order  
30 containing all of the prescription information required by this  
31 chapter and chapters 499 and 893 and signs that order.

32 (e) ~~(5)~~ The dispensing pharmacist notifies the prescriber  
33 of the emergency dispensing within a reasonable time after such  
34 dispensing.
