120.54 Rulemaking.—

(4) EMERGENCY RULES.—

(c) An emergency rule adopted under this subsection shall
 not be effective for a period longer than 90 days and shall not
 be renewable, except when the immediate danger is continuing and
 the agency has initiated rulemaking to adopt rules addressing
 the subject of the emergency rule and one of the following
conditions has delayed implementation of the rules either:
