No. 89-7 732, 80 Stat. 1161 (1966), was enacted and subsequently amended 8 to allow certain Cubans physically present in the United States 9 to be treated as aliens lawfully admitted for permanent 10 residence, creating what is often referred to as the "wet foot, 11 dry foot" policy, and 12 WHEREAS, this law provides Cuban migrants with an advantage 13 that migrants of other nationalities do not have, and 14 WHEREAS, at the time the law was enacted, the Cuban 15 government was not recognized by the United States, the 16 countries did not maintain diplomatic relations, travel between 17 the countries was severely restricted, and Cuban migrants were refugees from political oppression during the Cold War, and 18

WHEREAS, travel between the United States and Cuba is now considerably less restricted, NOW, THEREFORE,
