16	Representatives as to all unresolved issues. Upon receipt of the
17	notification, the presiding officers shall appoint a joint
18	select committee to review the position of the parties <u>relating</u>
19	to and render a recommended resolution of all issues remaining
20	at impasse. <u>No later than the 14th day of the regular session of</u>
21	the Legislature, the committee shall conduct a public hearing to
22	take testimony regarding the issues at impasse The recommended
23	resolution shall be returned by the joint select committee to
24	the presiding officers not later than 10 days prior to the date
25	upon which the legislative session is scheduled to commence.
26	During the legislative session, the Legislature shall take
27	action in accordance with this section.
