**Amendment (with directory and title amendments)**

Remove lines 52-71 and insert:

e. On transportation facilities constructed after July 1, 2017, there must be a distance of at least 5 miles between main through-lane tolling points. The distance requirement of this sub-subparagraph does not apply to entry and exit ramps. The authority may not increase a toll on an individual toll facility to implement this sub-subparagraph.

2. Notwithstanding s. 338.165 or any other provision of law to the contrary, in any county as defined in s. 125.011(1), to the extent surplus revenues exist, they may be used for purposes enumerated in subsection (8)(7), provided the

19 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
20 contrary, but subject to any contractual requirements contained  
21 in documents securing any outstanding indebtedness payable from

23 county commissioners may, by ordinance adopted on or before  
24 September 30, 1999, alter or abolish existing tolls and  
25 currently approved increases thereto if the board provides a  
26 local source of funding to the county expressway system for  
27 transportation in an amount sufficient to replace revenues  
28 necessary to meet bond obligations secured by such tolls and  
29 increases.

30 (6) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
31 contrary, but subject to any contractual requirements contained  
32 in the documents securing any indebtedness outstanding on July  
33 1, 2017, an authority in a county defined in s. 125.011(1),  
34 shall provide toll relief by reducing the tolls charged for  
35 SunPass customers by 3 percent on July 1, 2017.
