A bill to be entitled

An act relating to presentencing information; requiring the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OPPAGA) to conduct a study on the presentencing information provided to judges in this state and the manner by which that information is provided; requiring the office to examine alternative means of providing such information; requiring the Department of Corrections and the Office of the State Courts Administrator, upon request, to assist OPPAGA with the study; requiring OPPAGA, on or before a certain date, to submit a report to the Governor and the Legislature; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Office of Program Policy Analysis and
Government Accountability (OPPAGA) shall conduct a study on the
presentencing information provided to judges in this state and
the manner in which that information is provided. The study must
also examine alternatives to the way Florida provides judges
with presentencing information, such as Missouri's searchable
electronic database of sentencing information. The study must
include findings regarding the advantages, disadvantages, and
feasibility of the adoption in this state of features of other
states' models for providing presentencing information. Upon
request, the Department of Corrections and the Office of State
Courts Administrator shall assist OPPAGA by providing
information that it determines is necessary to complete its
