An act relating to the Marine Turtle Protection Act;
amending s. 921.0022, F.S.; adding the existing
offense of possession of any marine turtle species or
hatchling, or parts thereof, or nests to level 3 of
the offense severity ranking chart for the purpose of
increasing sentencing points for conviction of the
offense; updating a cross-reference; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of section 921.0022, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
