Between lines 59 and 60, insert:

5 (2) (a) When the governing body adopts a resolution 6 declaring the need for a community redevelopment agency, that 7 body shall, by ordinance, appoint a board of commissioners of 8 the community redevelopment agency, which shall consist of not 9 fewer than five or more than nine commissioners. The terms of office of the commissioners shall be for 4 years, except that 10 three of the members first appointed shall be designated to 11 serve terms of 1, 2, and 3 years, respectively, from the date of 12 their appointments, and all other members shall be designated to 13 923887

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serve for terms of 4 years from the date of their appointments. 14 A vacancy occurring during a term shall be filled for the 15 16 unexpired term. As provided in an interlocal agreement between 17 the governing body that created the agency and one or more 18 taxing authorities, one or more members of the board of 19 commissioners of the agency may be representatives of a taxing 20 authority, including members of that taxing authority's 21 governing body, whose membership on the board of commissioners 22 of the agency would be considered an additional duty of office as a member of the taxing authority governing body. 23

(b) Each taxing authority that provides at least a 20 24 25 percent tax contribution to a community redevelopment authority 26 must have representation on the governing body and the community 27 redevelopment agency unless the taxing authority chooses not to 28 serve on the governing board or community redevelopment agency. 29 The representation must be proportional to the percent of the 30 tax increment that the taxing authority contributes to the 31 community redevelopment agency. However, a municipality with a 32 population of 15,000 or fewer is not required to appoint a 33 representative from a taxing authority. 34
