(d) The supervisor of elections shall appoint the inspectors and clerks of elections, prepare and furnish the ballots, designate polling places, and canvass the returns of the election of board members by qualified electors. The county canvassing board shall declare and certify the results of the election.

(4) Members of the board, regardless of how elected, shall be public officers, shall be known as supervisors, and, upon

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14 entering into office, shall take and subscribe to the oath of
15 office as prescribed by s. 876.05, Florida Statutes. Members of
16 the board shall be subject to ethics and conflict of interest
17 laws of the state that apply to all local public officers. They
18 shall hold office for the terms for which they were elected or
19 appointed and until their successors are chosen and qualified.
20 If, during the term of office, a vacancy occurs, the remaining
21 members of the board shall fill each vacancy by an appointment
22 for the remainder of the unexpired term.

23 (5) Any elected member of the board of supervisors may be
24 removed by the Governor for malfeasance, misfeasance,
25 dishonesty, incompetency, or failure to perform the duties
26 imposed upon him or her by this act, and any vacancies that may
27 occur in such office for such reasons shall be filled by the
28 Governor as soon as practicable.

29 (6) A majority of the members of the board constitutes a
30 quorum for the purposes of conducting its business and
31 exercising its powers and for all other purposes. Action taken
32 by the district shall be upon a vote of a majority of the
33 members present unless general law or a rule of the district
34 requires a greater number.

35 (7) As soon as practicable after each election or
36 appointment, the board shall organize by electing one of its
37 members as chair and by electing a secretary, who need not be a

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38 member of the board, and such other officers as the board may
39 deem necessary.

40 (8) The board shall keep a permanent record book entitled
41 "Record of Proceedings of Sunbridge Stewardship District," in
42 which shall be recorded minutes of all meetings, resolutions,
43 proceedings, certificates, bonds given by all employees, and any
44 and all corporate acts. The record book and all other district
45 records shall at reasonable times be opened to inspection in the
46 same manner as state, county, and municipal records pursuant to
47 chapter 119, Florida Statutes. The record book shall be kept at
48 the office or other regular place of business maintained by the
49 board in a designated location in Osceola County.

50 (9) Each supervisor shall not be entitled to receive
51 compensation for his or her services; however, each supervisor
52 shall receive travel and per diem expenses as set forth in s.
53 112.061, Florida Statutes.

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
