40 (8) (a) The department must discontinue the issuance of an
41 approved specialty license plate if the number of valid
42 specialty plate registrations falls below 1,000 plates for at
43 least 12 consecutive months. A warning letter shall be mailed to
44 the sponsoring organization following the first month in which
45 the total number of valid specialty plate registrations is below
46 1,000 plates. This paragraph does not apply to collegiate
47 license plates established under s. 320.08058(3) or specialty
48 license plates that have statutory eligibility limitations for
49 purchase.

50 (b) The department is authorized to discontinue the
51 issuance of a specialty license plate and distribution of
52 associated annual use fee proceeds if the organization no longer
53 exists, if the organization has stopped providing services that
54 are authorized to be funded from the annual use fee proceeds, if
55 the organization does not meet the presale requirements as
56 prescribed in s. 320.08053, or pursuant to an organizational
57 recipient's request. Organizations shall notify the department
58 immediately to stop all warrants for plate sales if any of the
59 conditions in this section exist and must meet the requirements
60 of s. 320.08062 for any period of operation during a fiscal
61 year.

62 (c) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), on January 1 of each
63 year, the department shall discontinue the specialty license

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64 plate with the fewest number of plates in circulation over the
65 previous 24 months. A warning letter shall be mailed to the
66 sponsoring organization following the first month in which the
67 total number of valid specialty license plate registrations is
68 the fewest in circulation over the previous 24 months.

69 (d) A person issued a specialty license plate that has
70 been discontinued by the department may keep the discontinued
71 specialty license plate for the remainder of the 10-year license
72 plate replacement period and must pay all other applicable
73 registration fees. However, such person is exempt from paying
74 the applicable specialty license plate annual use fee under
75 subsection (4) for the remainder of the 10-year license plate
76 replacement period.

77 (e) If the department discontinues issuance of a specialty
78 license plate, all annual use fees currently held or collected
79 by the department for that plate shall be distributed to
80 recipients or subrecipients of the proceeds in good standing
81 within 180 days after the date the specialty license plate is
82 discontinued. Of those fees, the department shall retain an
83 amount sufficient to defray the applicable administrative and
84 inventory closeout costs associated with discontinuance of the
85 plate. The remaining funds shall be distributed to the
86 organization or organizations specified in s. 320.08058.

87 (f) If an organization that is the intended recipient of
88 the funds pursuant to s. 320.08058 or its subrecipients no

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89 longer exist, the department shall deposit any undisbursed funds
90 into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.

91 (10) (a) A specialty license plate annual use fee collected
92 and distributed under this chapter, or any interest earned from
93 those fees, may not be used for commercial or for-profit
94 activities nor for general or administrative expenses, except as
95 authorized by s. 320.08058 or to pay the cost of the audit or
96 report required by s. 320.08062(1). The fees and any interest
97 earned from the fees may be expended only for use in this state
98 unless the annual use fee is derived from the sale of United
99 States Armed Forces and veterans-related specialty license
100 plates pursuant to paragraphs (4) (d), (bb), (kk), (iii), and
101 (uuu) ~~(ll), (kkk), and (yyy)~~ and s. 320.0891 or out-of-state
102 college or university license plates pursuant to paragraph
103 (4) (bbbb).

124 ~~(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 320.08053, the~~

127 ~~top of the plate, and the words "American Red Cross" must appear~~
128 ~~at the bottom of the plate.~~

129 ~~(b) The department shall retain all revenues from the sale~~

148 ~~(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Transplant~~

162 ~~bottom of the plate.~~

163 ~~(64)(66) IN GOD WE TRUST LICENSE PLATES.—~~

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164 (b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed
165 to the In God We Trust Foundation, Inc., which may use up to 10
166 percent of the proceeds to offset administrative costs,
167 promotion, and marketing of the license plate directly
168 associated with the operations of the foundation. The remaining
169 proceeds may be used to address the needs of the military
170 community and the public safety community; provide educational
171 grants and scholarships to foster self-reliance and stability in
172 Florida's youth; and provide education in ~~to fund educational~~
173 ~~scholarships for the children of Florida residents who are~~
174 ~~members of the United States Armed Forces, the National Guard,~~
175 ~~and the United States Armed Forces Reserve and for the children~~

201 ~~plate, and the words "St. Johns River" must appear at the bottom~~
202 ~~of the plate.~~

203 ~~(b) The requirements of s. 320.08053 must be met prior to~~
204 ~~the issuance of the plate. Thereafter, the license plate annual~~
205 ~~use fees shall be distributed to the St. Johns River Alliance,~~
206 ~~Inc., a s. 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, which shall~~

246 ~~(a) Notwithstanding the requirements of s. 320.08053, the~~
247 ~~department shall develop a Hispanic Achievers license plate as~~
248 ~~provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and~~
249 ~~design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must~~
250 ~~appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Hispanic~~
251 ~~Achievers" must appear at the bottom of the plate.~~

252 ~~(b) The proceeds from the license plate annual use fee~~
253 ~~shall be distributed to National Hispanic Corporate Achievers,~~
254 ~~Inc., a nonprofit corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal~~
255 ~~Revenue Code, to fund grants to nonprofit organizations to~~
256 ~~operate programs and provide scholarships and for marketing the~~
257 ~~Hispanic Achievers license plate. National Hispanic Corporate~~
258 ~~Achievers, Inc., shall establish a Hispanic Achievers Grant~~

303 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Police
304 and Kids Foundation, Inc., which may use up to a maximum of 10
305 percent of the proceeds for marketing to promote and market the
306 plate. The remainder of the proceeds shall be used by the Police
307 and Kids Foundation, Inc., for its operations, activities,
308 programs, and projects to invest and reinvest, and the interest
309 earnings shall be used for the operation of the Police and Kids
310 Foundation, Inc.

311 (80) AUBURN UNIVERSITY LICENSE PLATES.-

312 (a) The department shall develop an Auburn University
313 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The

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314 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
315 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
316 plate, and the words "War Eagle" must appear at the bottom of
317 the plate.

318 (b) The Tampa Bay Auburn Club is the lead club on behalf
319 of the Auburn clubs in this state. The annual use fees from the
320 sale of the plate shall be distributed to the Tampa Bay Auburn
321 Club, together with statistics on sales of the license plates
322 tabulated by county. The Tampa Bay Auburn Club must distribute
323 to each of the state's Auburn clubs on a pro-rata basis the
324 moneys received from sales in the regions within the respective
325 club's area for the purpose of awarding scholarships to Florida
326 residents attending Auburn University. Students receiving these
327 scholarships must be eligible for the Florida Bright Futures
328 Scholarship Program pursuant to s. 1009.531 and shall use the
329 scholarship funds for tuition and other expenses related to
330 attending Auburn University.

331 (81) BEAT CHILDHOOD CANCER LICENSE PLATES.-

332 (a) The department shall develop a Beat Childhood Cancer
333 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
334 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
335 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
336 plate, and the words "Beat Childhood Cancer" must appear at the
337 bottom of the plate.

338 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall

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339 be distributed to Beat Nb, Inc., which may use up to 10 percent
340 of the proceeds for administrative costs directly associated
341 with the operation of the corporation and for marketing and
342 promoting the plate. The remaining proceeds shall be used by the
343 corporation to fund pediatric cancer treatment and research.

344 (82) FLORIDA STATE BEEKEEPERS ASSOCIATION LICENSE PLATES.-

345 (a) The department shall develop a Florida State
346 Beekeepers Association license plate as provided in this section
347 and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design
348 approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at
349 the top of the plate, and the words "Save the Bees" must appear
350 at the bottom of the plate.

351 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
352 be distributed to the Florida State Beekeepers Association, a
353 nonprofit corporation, and shall be used to fund outreach and
354 education to raise awareness of the importance of beekeeping to
355 Florida agriculture and to fund honeybee research and husbandry.

356 (83) AMERICAN EAGLE LICENSE PLATES.-

357 (a) The department shall develop an American Eagle license
358 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
359 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
360 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
361 words "God Bless America" must appear at the bottom of the
362 plate.

363 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall

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364 be distributed to the American Eagle Foundation for deposit in
365 the foundation's national endowment fund. Up to 10 percent of
366 the funds received may be used for administrative costs and
367 marketing of the plate. The American Eagle Foundation shall use
368 the remainder of the proceeds to fund public education programs,
369 rescue and care programs, and other conservation efforts in
370 Florida that benefit bald eagles.

371 (84) DAN MARINO FOUNDATION LICENSE PLATES.-

372 (a) The department shall develop a Dan Marino Foundation
373 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
374 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
375 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
376 plate, and the words "Marino Campus" must appear at the bottom
377 of the plate.

378 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
379 be distributed to the Dan Marino Foundation, Inc., a Florida
380 nonprofit corporation, which may use up to 10 percent of such
381 fees for administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The
382 remainder of the fees shall be used by the Dan Marino
383 Foundation, Inc., to assist Floridians with developmental
384 disabilities in becoming employed, independent, and productive;
385 to promote awareness of such services; and to promote and fund
386 education scholarships related to such services.

387 (85) DUCKS UNLIMITED LICENSE PLATES.-

388 (a) The department shall develop a Ducks Unlimited license

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389 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
390 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
391 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
392 words "Conserving Florida Wetlands" must appear at the bottom of
393 the plate.

394 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
395 be distributed to Ducks Unlimited, Inc., a nonprofit corporation
396 under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be used as
397 follows:

398 1. Up to 5 percent may be used for administrative costs
399 and marketing of the plate.

400 2. At least 95 percent shall be used in this state to
401 support the mission and efforts of Ducks Unlimited, Inc., to
402 conserve, restore, and manage Florida's wetlands and associated
403 habitats for the benefit of waterfowl, other wildlife, and
404 people.

405 (86) FLORIDA BAY FOREVER LICENSE PLATES.-

406 (a) The department shall develop a Florida Bay Forever
407 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
408 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
409 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
410 plate, and the words "Florida Bay Forever" must appear at the
411 bottom of the plate.

412 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
413 be distributed to the Florida National Park Association, Inc.,

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414 which may use up to 10 percent of the proceeds for
415 administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The remainder
416 of the funds shall be used to supplement the Everglades National
417 Park's budgets and to support educational, interpretive,
418 historical, and scientific research relating to the Everglades
419 National Park.

420 (87) SUPPORT OUR CONSTITUTION LICENSE PLATES.-

421 (a) The department shall develop a Support Our
422 Constitution license plate as provided in this section and s.
423 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by
424 the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
425 plate, and the words "Support Our Constitution" must appear at
426 the bottom of the plate.

427 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
428 be distributed to the Constitution Foundation, Inc., to be used
429 as follows:

430 1. Up to 10 percent may be used for administrative costs.

431 2. The remainder shall be used to fund the activities,
432 programs, projects, and mission of the Constitution Foundation,
433 Inc., to increase awareness and understanding of the United
434 States Constitution in Florida's public schools, recruit and
435 train school leaders to make presentations in each school
