3 s. 320.08053, F.S.; revising presale specialty license
4 plate voucher requirements; prohibiting development of
5 new specialty license plates except under certain
6 circumstances; providing requirements for issuance of
7 such plates; amending s. 320.08056, F.S.; deleting and
8 establishing annual use fees for certain specialty
9 license plates; revising provisions for discontinuing
10 issuance of a specialty license plate; providing for
11 payment and distribution of fees for discontinued
12 plates; providing an exception to the requirement that
13 certain fees and interest be expended only for use in
14 this state; providing applicability; amending s.
15 320.08058, F.S.; revising the design of, deleting
16 provisions relating to, revising distribution of
17 proceeds from the sale of, and directing the
18 Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to
19 create certain specialty license plates; providing an
20 effective date.

22 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

24 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section
25 320.08053, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (3) is



26 | added to that section, to read:

27 | 320.08053 Establishment of Requirements for requests to
28 | ~~establish~~ specialty license plates.-

30 | (b) Within 24 months after the presale specialty license
31 | plate voucher is established, the approved specialty license
32 | plate organization must record with the department a minimum of
33 | 1,000 voucher sales or, if the organization is an out-of-state
34 | college or university, 3,000 voucher sales, before manufacture
35 | of the license plate may commence. If, at the conclusion of the
36 | 24-month presale period, the minimum sales requirements have not
37 | been met, the specialty plate is deauthorized and the department
38 | shall discontinue development of the plate and discontinue
39 | issuance of the presale vouchers. Upon deauthorization of the
40 | license plate, a purchaser of the license plate voucher may use
41 | the annual use fee collected as a credit towards any other
42 | specialty license plate or apply for a refund on a form
43 | prescribed by the department.

44 | (3) (a) If the Legislature has approved 125 or more
45 | specialty license plates, the department may not make any new
46 | specialty license plates available for design, presale, or
47 | issuance until a sufficient number of plates are discontinued
48 | pursuant to s. 320.08056(8) such that the number of plates being
49 | issued is reduced to fewer than 125.

50 | (b) New specialty license plates that have been approved



51 by law but are awaiting issuance under paragraph (a) shall be
 52 issued in the order they appear in s. 320.08056(4). All other
 53 provisions of this section must also be met before a plate is
 54 issued.

- 99 | (8) (a) The department must discontinue the issuance of an
- 100 | approved specialty license plate if the number of valid



101 specialty plate registrations falls below 1,000 plates for at
102 least 12 consecutive months. A warning letter shall be mailed to
103 the sponsoring organization following the first month in which
104 the total number of valid specialty plate registrations is below
105 1,000 plates. This paragraph does not apply to collegiate
106 license plates established under s. 320.08058(3) or specialty
107 license plates that have statutory eligibility limitations for
108 purchase.

109 (b) The department is authorized to discontinue the
110 issuance of a specialty license plate and distribution of
111 associated annual use fee proceeds if the organization no longer
112 exists, if the organization has stopped providing services that
113 are authorized to be funded from the annual use fee proceeds, if
114 the organization does not meet the presale requirements as
115 prescribed in s. 320.08053, or pursuant to an organizational
116 recipient's request. Organizations shall notify the department
117 immediately to stop all warrants for plate sales if any of the
118 conditions in this section exist and must meet the requirements
119 of s. 320.08062 for any period of operation during a fiscal
120 year.

121 (c) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), on January 1 of each
122 year, the department shall discontinue the specialty license
123 plate with the fewest number of plates in circulation over the
124 previous 24 months. A warning letter shall be mailed to the
125 sponsoring organization following the first month in which the



126 total number of valid specialty license plate registrations is
127 the fewest in circulation over the previous 24 months.

128 (d) A person issued a specialty license plate that has
129 been discontinued by the department may keep the discontinued
130 specialty license plate for the remainder of the 10-year license
131 plate replacement period and must pay all other applicable
132 registration fees. However, such person is exempt from paying
133 the applicable specialty license plate annual use fee under
134 subsection (4) for the remainder of the 10-year license plate
135 replacement period.

136 (e) If the department discontinues issuance of a specialty
137 license plate, all annual use fees currently held or collected
138 by the department for that plate shall be distributed to
139 recipients or subrecipients of the proceeds in good standing
140 within 180 days after the date the specialty license plate is
141 discontinued. Of those fees, the department shall retain an
142 amount sufficient to defray the applicable administrative and
143 inventory closeout costs associated with discontinuance of the
144 plate. The remaining funds shall be distributed to the
145 organization or organizations specified in s. 320.08058.

146 (f) If an organization that is the intended recipient of
147 the funds pursuant to s. 320.08058 or its subrecipients no
148 longer exist, the department shall deposit any undisbursed funds
149 into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.

150 (10) (a) A specialty license plate annual use fee collected



151 and distributed under this chapter, or any interest earned from
152 those fees, may not be used for commercial or for-profit
153 activities nor for general or administrative expenses, except as
154 authorized by s. 320.08058 or to pay the cost of the audit or
155 report required by s. 320.08062(1). The fees and any interest
156 earned from the fees may be expended only for use in this state
157 unless the annual use fee is derived from the sale of United
158 States Armed Forces and veterans-related specialty license
159 plates pursuant to paragraphs (4)(d), (bb), (kk), (iii), and
160 (uuu) ~~(ll)~~, ~~(kkk)~~, and ~~(yyy)~~ and s. 320.0891 or out-of-state
161 college or university license plates pursuant to paragraph
162 (4)(bbbb) and (www).

163 Section 3. Subsections (32) through (56) of section
164 320.08058, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (31)
165 through (55), respectively, subsections (58) through (68) are
166 renumbered as subsections (56) through (66), respectively,
167 subsections (71) through (83) are renumbered as subsections (67)
168 through (79), respectively, paragraph (a) of subsection (7),
169 paragraph (a) of present subsection (65), paragraph (b) of

171 (80), and present subsections (31), (57), (69), and (70) are

178 design and colors that are approved by the department. The word

181 bottom ~~top~~ of the plate.

183 ~~(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 320.08053, the~~
184 ~~department shall develop an American Red Cross license plate as~~
185 ~~provided in this section. The word "Florida" must appear at the~~
186 ~~top of the plate, and the words "American Red Cross" must appear~~
187 ~~at the bottom of the plate.~~

188 ~~(b) The department shall retain all revenues from the sale~~
189 ~~of such plates until all startup costs for developing and~~
190 ~~issuing the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, 50 percent~~
191 ~~of the annual use fees shall be distributed to the American Red~~
192 ~~Cross Chapter of Central Florida, with statistics on sales of~~

203 ~~(a) The department shall develop a Donate Organs Pass It~~
 204 ~~On license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"~~
 205 ~~must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Donate~~
 206 ~~Organs Pass It On" must appear at the bottom of the plate.~~

207 ~~(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Transplant~~
 208 ~~Foundation, Inc., and shall use up to 10 percent of the proceeds~~
 209 ~~from the annual use fee for marketing and administrative costs~~
 210 ~~that are directly associated with the management and~~
 211 ~~distribution of the proceeds. The remaining proceeds shall be~~

217 (a) The department shall develop a Lighthouse Association
 218 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"
 219 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words
 220 "SaveOurLighthouses.org ~~Visit Our Lights~~" must appear at the
 221 bottom of the plate.

222 ~~(64)~~ (66) IN GOD WE TRUST LICENSE PLATES.—

223 (b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed
 224 to the In God We Trust Foundation, Inc., which may use up to 10
 225 percent of the proceeds to offset administrative costs,



226 promotion, and marketing of the license plate directly
227 associated with the operations of the foundation. The remaining
228 proceeds may be used to address the needs of the military
229 community and the public safety community; provide educational
230 grants and scholarships to foster self-reliance and stability in
231 Florida's youth; and provide education in ~~to fund educational~~
232 ~~scholarships for the children of Florida residents who are~~
233 ~~members of the United States Armed Forces, the National Guard,~~
234 ~~and the United States Armed Forces Reserve and for the children~~
235 ~~of public safety employees who have died in the line of duty who~~

256 ~~(a) The department shall develop a St. Johns River license~~
257 ~~plate as provided in this section. The St. Johns River license~~
258 ~~plates must bear the colors and design approved by the~~
259 ~~department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the~~
260 ~~plate, and the words "St. Johns River" must appear at the bottom~~
261 ~~of the plate.~~

262 ~~(b) The requirements of s. 320.08053 must be met prior to~~
263 ~~the issuance of the plate. Thereafter, the license plate annual~~
264 ~~use fees shall be distributed to the St. Johns River Alliance,~~
265 ~~Inc., a s. 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, which shall~~
266 ~~administer the fees as follows:~~

267 ~~1. The St. Johns River Alliance, Inc., shall retain the~~
268 ~~first \$60,000 of the annual use fees as direct reimbursement for~~

305 ~~(a) Notwithstanding the requirements of s. 320.08053, the~~
306 ~~department shall develop a Hispanic Achievers license plate as~~
307 ~~provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and~~
308 ~~design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must~~
309 ~~appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Hispanic~~
310 ~~Achievers" must appear at the bottom of the plate.~~

311 ~~(b) The proceeds from the license plate annual use fee~~
312 ~~shall be distributed to National Hispanic Corporate Achievers,~~
313 ~~Inc., a nonprofit corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal~~
314 ~~Revenue Code, to fund grants to nonprofit organizations to~~
315 ~~operate programs and provide scholarships and for marketing the~~
316 ~~Hispanic Achievers license plate. National Hispanic Corporate~~
317 ~~Achievers, Inc., shall establish a Hispanic Achievers Grant~~
318 ~~Council that shall provide recommendations for statewide grants~~

362 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Police
363 and Kids Foundation, Inc., which may use up to a maximum of 10
364 percent of the proceeds for marketing to promote and market the
365 plate. The remainder of the proceeds shall be used by the Police
366 and Kids Foundation, Inc., for its operations, activities,
367 programs, and projects to invest and reinvest, and the interest
368 earnings shall be used for the operation of the Police and Kids
369 Foundation, Inc.

370 (80) AUBURN UNIVERSITY LICENSE PLATES.-

371 (a) The department shall develop an Auburn University
372 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
373 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
374 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
375 plate, and the words "War Eagle" must appear at the bottom of



376 | the plate.

377 | (b) The Tampa Bay Auburn Club is the lead club on behalf
378 | of the Auburn clubs in this state. The annual use fees from the
379 | sale of the plate shall be distributed to the Tampa Bay Auburn
380 | Club, together with statistics on sales of the license plates
381 | tabulated by county. The Tampa Bay Auburn Club must distribute
382 | to each of the state's Auburn clubs on a pro-rata basis the
383 | moneys received from sales in the regions within the respective
384 | club's area for the purpose of awarding scholarships to Florida
385 | residents attending Auburn University. Students receiving these
386 | scholarships must be eligible for the Florida Bright Futures
387 | Scholarship Program pursuant to s. 1009.531 and shall use the

391 | (a) The department shall develop a Beat Childhood Cancer
392 | license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
393 | plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
394 | department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
395 | plate, and the words "Beat Childhood Cancer" must appear at the
396 | bottom of the plate.

397 | (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
398 | be distributed to Beat Nb, Inc., which may use up to 10 percent
399 | of the proceeds for administrative costs directly associated
400 | with the operation of the corporation and for marketing and



401 promoting the plate. The remaining proceeds shall be used by the
402 corporation to fund pediatric cancer treatment and research.

403 (82) FLORIDA STATE BEEKEEPERS ASSOCIATION LICENSE PLATES.—

404 (a) The department shall develop a Florida State
405 Beekeepers Association license plate as provided in this section
406 and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design
407 approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at
408 the top of the plate, and the words "Save the Bees" must appear
409 at the bottom of the plate.

410 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
411 be distributed to the Florida State Beekeepers Association, a
412 nonprofit corporation, and shall be used to fund outreach and
413 education to raise awareness of the importance of beekeeping to
414 Florida agriculture and to fund honeybee research and husbandry.

415 (83) AMERICAN EAGLE LICENSE PLATES.—

416 (a) The department shall develop an American Eagle license
417 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
418 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
419 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
420 words "In God We Trust" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

421 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
422 be distributed to the American Eagle Foundation for deposit in
423 the foundation's national endowment fund. Up to 10 percent of
424 the funds received may be used for administrative costs and
425 marketing of the plate. The American Eagle Foundation shall use



426 the remainder of the proceeds to fund public education programs,
427 rescue and care programs, and other conservation efforts in
428 Florida that benefit bald eagles.

429 (84) DAN MARINO FOUNDATION LICENSE PLATES.—

438 nonprofit corporation, which may use up to 10 percent of such
439 fees for administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The
440 remainder of the fees shall be used by the Dan Marino
441 Foundation, Inc., to assist Floridians with developmental
442 disabilities in becoming employed, independent, and productive;
443 to promote awareness of such services; and to promote and fund
444 education scholarships related to such services.

445 (85) DUCKS UNLIMITED LICENSE PLATES.—

446 (a) The department shall develop a Ducks Unlimited license
447 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
448 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
449 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
450 words "Conserving Florida Wetlands" must appear at the bottom of

452 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
453 be distributed to Ducks Unlimited, Inc., a nonprofit corporation
454 under s. 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be used as
455 follows:

456 1. Up to 5 percent may be used for administrative costs
457 and marketing of the plate.

458 2. At least 95 percent shall be used in this state to
459 support the mission and efforts of Ducks Unlimited, Inc., to
460 conserve, restore, and manage Florida's wetlands and associated
461 habitats for the benefit of waterfowl, other wildlife, and
462 people.

463 (86) FLORIDA BAY FOREVER LICENSE PLATES.—

472 which may use up to 10 percent of the proceeds for
473 administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The remainder
474 of the funds shall be used to supplement the Everglades National
475 Park's budgets and to support educational, interpretive,



476 historical, and scientific research relating to the Everglades
477 National Park.

478 (87) SUPPORT OUR CONSTITUTION LICENSE PLATES.-

479 (a) The department shall develop a Support Our
480 Constitution license plate as provided in this section and s.
481 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by
482 the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the

485 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
486 be distributed to the Constitution Foundation, Inc., to be used
487 as follows:

488 1. Up to 10 percent may be used for administrative costs.

489 2. The remainder shall be used to fund the activities,
490 programs, projects, and mission of the Constitution Foundation,
491 Inc., to increase awareness and understanding of the United
492 States Constitution in Florida's public schools, recruit and
493 train school leaders to make presentations in each school
494 district, and provide to each student, at no charge, learning
495 materials and a pocket Constitution.

496 (88) DONATE LIFE FLORIDA LICENSE PLATES.-

497 (a) The department shall develop a Donate Life Florida
498 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
499 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
500 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the



501 plate, and the words "Donors Save Lives" must appear at the
502 bottom of the plate.

503 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
504 be distributed to Donate Life Florida, which may use up to 10
505 percent of the proceeds for marketing and administrative costs.
506 The remaining proceeds shall be used by Donate Life Florida to
507 educate Florida residents on the importance of organ, tissue,
508 and eye donation and for the continued maintenance of the Joshua
509 Abbott Organ and Tissue Donor Registry.

510 (89) RONALD REAGAN LICENSE PLATES.—

511 (a) The department shall develop a Ronald Reagan license
512 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
513 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The

517 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
518 be distributed to Florida Ronald Reagan Centennial, Inc., to be
519 used as follows:

520 1. Ten percent shall be used for marketing and
521 administrative costs.

522 2. Forty-five percent shall be distributed to the Florida
523 National Guard Foundation.

524 3. Forty-five percent shall be used to support ongoing
525 research of Alzheimer's disease for the benefit of Florida



526 residents and their families who suffer from the disease.

572 2. Ninety-five percent shall be used for college
573 scholarships for Florida residents attending historically black
574 colleges and universities in the state.



575 (93) SIGMA GAMMA RHO SORORITY LICENSE PLATES.—

576 (a) The department shall develop a Sigma Gamma Rho
577 Sorority license plate as provided in this section and s.

582 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall

670 2. An additional 30 percent shall be distributed to the

673 remainder shall be used as follows:

689 5. Twenty-five percent shall be distributed to Greater
690 Caribbean American Cultural Coalition, Inc., to be used to
691 promote awareness of Caribbean culture within this state. Of
692 this amount, up to 5 percent may be used for administrative
693 expenses.

694 6. Ten percent shall be distributed to Little Haiti
695 Optimist Foundation, Inc., to be used to promote awareness of
696 Caribbean culture and youth development within this state. Of



697 this amount, up to 5 percent may be used for administrative
698 expenses.

699 (101) UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA LICENSE PLATES.—

700 (a) The department shall develop a University of Georgia
701 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
702 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
703 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
704 plate, and the words "The University of Georgia" must appear at
705 the bottom of the plate.

706 (b) The Georgia Bulldog Club of Jacksonville is the lead
707 club on behalf of the University of Georgia Booster Clubs in
708 this state. The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
709 be distributed to the Georgia Bulldog Club of Jacksonville,
710 together with statistics on sales of the license plates
711 tabulated by county. The Georgia Bulldog Club of Jacksonville
712 must distribute to each of the state's University of Georgia
713 Booster Clubs on a pro-rata basis the moneys received from sales
714 in the regions within the respective club's area for the purpose
715 of awarding scholarships to Florida residents attending the
716 University of Georgia. Students receiving these scholarships
717 must be eligible for the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship
718 Program pursuant to s. 1009.531 and shall use the scholarship
719 funds for tuition and other expenses related to attending the
720 University of Georgia.

721 Section 4. This act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
