27	investment by the Florida Film Investment Corporation in a
28	production be exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s.
29	24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. If the personal
30	financial records, trade secrets, and proprietary information of
31	persons applying for an equity investment were subject to
32	disclosure, a chilling effect on participation would result.
33	There is a strong likelihood that productions would choose not
34	to apply for equity investments from the Florida Film Investment
35	Corporation. Since productions are required to make in-state
36	expenditures as a condition of receiving such investments, the
37	chilling effect caused by such disclosure would undermine the
38	public purpose of the Florida Film Investment Corporation to
39	encourage this state to be used as a site for scripted
40	productions and would consequently result in productions being
41	produced outside of the state.
42	Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date
43	that HB 1345 or similar legislation takes effect, if such
44	legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an
45	extension thereof and becomes a law.
