4 Remove lines 267-313 and insert:

5 3. Determined that the medical use of marijuana would
6 likely outweigh the potential health risks for the patient. If a
7 patient is younger than 18 years of age, a second physician must
8 concur with this determination, and such determination must be
9 documented in the patient's medical record.

10 4. Reviewed the patient's controlled drug prescription
11 history in the prescription drug monitoring program database
12 established pursuant to s. 893.055.

13 5. Reviewed the medical marijuana use registry and

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14 confirmed that the patient does not have an active physician
15 certification from another qualified physician.

16 6. Registers as the issuer of the physician certification
17 for the named qualified patient on the medical marijuana use
18 registry in an electronic manner determined by the department,
19 and:

20 a. Enters into the registry the contents of the physician
21 certification, including the patient's qualifying condition and
22 the dosage not to exceed the daily dose amount determined by the
23 department, the amount and forms of marijuana authorized for the
24 patient, and any types of marijuana delivery devices needed by
25 the patient for the medical use of marijuana.

26 b. Updates the registry within 7 days after any change is
27 made to the original physician certification to reflect such
28 change.

29 c. Deactivates the registration of the qualified patient
30 and the patient's caregiver when the physician no longer
31 recommends the medical use of marijuana for the patient.

32 7. Maintains an individualized patient treatment plan that
33 includes the qualified patient's qualifying condition and the
34 dose, route of administration, planned duration, treatment
35 objectives, plan for assessing and monitoring the qualified
36 patient's risk of aberrant drug-related behavior, and plan for
37 monitoring the qualified patient's symptoms and other indicators
38 of tolerance or reaction to the marijuana.

40 | University of Florida College of Pharmacy for research on the
41 | safety and efficacy of marijuana.
