A bill to be entitled

An act relating to correctional privatization; prohibiting the entry into or renewal of contracts relating to correctional privatization after a specified date; providing for custody of inmates after the expiration of such contracts; providing for future repeal of ch. 957, F.S., relating to correctional privatization; providing a directive to the Division of Law Revision and Information; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) Effective upon this act becoming a law and notwithstanding any other law, no contract may be entered into or renewed under chapter 957, Florida Statutes.

(2) Upon the expiration of a contract under chapter 957,
Florida Statutes, all inmates housed pursuant to such contract
shall be returned to the custody of the Department of
Corrections.

Section 2. Upon the expiration of all contracts under chapter 957, Florida Statutes, that are in effect on the effective date of this act, that chapter, consisting of ss. 957.01, 957.02, 957.04, 957.05, 957.06, 957.07, 957.08, 957.09, 957.11, 957.12, 957.13, 957.14, 957.15, and 957.16, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

Section 3. The Division of Law Revision and Information is directed to prepare a reviser's bill to conform the Florida

Statutes to the repeals under section 2 of this act to be
