18	nonalcoholic beverages that are prepared, served, and consumed
19	on such premises. For the purposes of this act, the term "event
20	center" means a facility that routinely hosts events for which
21	entrance is by customers who have purchased tickets, including,
22	but not limited to, musical concerts and art shows; hosts events
23	sponsored or organized by nonprofit organizations; and otherwise
24	does not market itself primarily as a food service
