Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 531.37, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

531.37 Definitions.—As used in this chapter:

(1) "Weights and measures" means all weights and measures of every kind, instruments, and devices for weighing and measuring, and any appliance and accessories associated with any or all such instruments and devices, excluding any device that measures time and distance for the purpose of charging a fare for the transportation of persons in a motor vehicle and those weights and measures used for the purpose of inspecting the accuracy of devices used in conjunction with aviation fuel.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 531.61, Florida Statutes, is amended, and present subsections (2) and (3) of that section are redesignated as subsections (1) and (2), respectively, to read:

531.61 Exemptions from permit requirement.—Commercial weights or measures instruments or devices are exempt from the
