7 322.0511 Veteran identification cards.-

8 (1) The department, in cooperation with the Department of
9 Veterans' Affairs, shall create a veteran identification card to
10 be used as proof of veteran status for the purpose of obtaining
11 discounts or waivers offered to veterans for the exchange of
12 goods and services and for other purposes authorized by law,
13 except as provided in subsection (3). Veteran identification
14 cards shall be issued by the department by mail. The veteran
15 identification card must bear the colors and design approved by
16 the department, including, but not limited to:

17 (a) In the foreground, a full-face photograph of the
18 veteran and his or her full name, branch of service, and date of
19 discharge. The words "Proof of veteran status" must appear at
20 the bottom of the card.

21 (2) The department shall issue a veteran identification
22 card to a veteran of any branch of the United States Armed
23 Forces who has been honorably discharged and who provides to the
24 department:

25 (a) A copy of the veteran's DD Form 214 as issued by the
26 United States Department of Defense.

27 (b) A copy of the veteran's valid, unexpired driver
28 license or identification card as issued under this chapter or
29 another form of photographic identification acceptable to the
30 department.

31 (c) Payment of a \$10 fee to be deposited into the Highway
32 Safety Operating Trust Fund.

33 (3) A veteran identification card issued pursuant to this
34 section is not considered an identification card for the
35 purposes of s. 295.17 or s. 322.051 and may not be used for the
36 determination of any federal benefit.

37 (4) A veteran identification card shall be terminated upon
38 death of the applicant.

39 (5) REPEAL. -This section is repealed August 31, 2022.
