24 (a) The department shall develop an Alpha Phi Alpha
25 Fraternity license plate as provided in this section and s.
26 320.08053. The plates must bear the colors and design approved
27 by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of
28 the plate, and the name of the fraternity must appear at the
29 bottom of the plate.

30 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
31 be distributed as follows:

32 1. Ten percent shall be distributed to the Florida
33 Federation of Alpha Chapters, Inc., and used solely for
34 marketing of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., license
35 plate.

36 2. Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the Florida
37 Federation of Alpha Chapters, Inc., and used to promote
38 community awareness and action through educational, economic,
39 and cultural service activities within Florida.

40 3. Five percent shall be distributed to the United Negro

48 by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of
49 the plate, and the name of the fraternity must appear at the
50 bottom of the plate.

51 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
52 be distributed as follows:

53 1. Ten percent shall be distributed to the State of
54 Florida Omega Friendship Foundation, Inc., and used solely for
55 marketing of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., license plate.

91 bottom of the plate.

110 plate, and the name of the sorority must appear at the bottom of
111 the plate.

112 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
113 be distributed as follows:

114 1. Ten percent shall be distributed to Florida Pearls,
115 Inc., and used solely for marketing of the Zeta Phi Beta
116 Sorority, Inc., license plate.

130 the plate, and the name of the sorority must appear at the
131 bottom of the plate.

132 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
133 be distributed as follows:

134 1. Ten percent shall be distributed to the Delta Research
135 and Educational Foundation, Inc., and used solely for marketing
136 of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., license plate.

137 2. Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the Delta
138 Research and Educational Foundation, Inc., and used to promote
139 community awareness and action through educational, economic,
140 and cultural service activities within Florida.

151 bottom of the plate.

152 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
153 be distributed as follows:

154 1. Ten percent shall be distributed to the Alpha Kappa
155 Alpha Educational Advancement Foundation, Inc., and used solely
156 for marketing of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., license
157 plate.

158 2. Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the Alpha
159 Kappa Alpha Educational Advancement Foundation, Inc., and used
160 to promote community awareness and action through educational,
161 economic, and cultural service activities within Florida.

162 3. Five percent shall be distributed to the United Negro
163 College Fund, Inc., to be used for college scholarships for
164 Florida residents attending Florida's historically black
165 colleges and universities.

171 the plate, and the name of the sorority must appear at the
172 bottom of the plate.

173 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
174 be distributed as follows:

175 1. Ten percent shall be distributed to the Sigma Gamma Rho
176 Sorority National Education Fund, Inc., and used solely for
177 marketing of the Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc., license plate.

178 2. Eighty-five percent shall be distributed to the Sigma
179 Gamma Rho Sorority National Education Fund, Inc., and used to
180 promote community awareness and action through educational,
181 economic, and cultural service activities.

182 3. Five percent shall be distributed to the United Negro
183 College Fund, Inc., to be used for college scholarships for
184 Florida residents attending Florida's historically black
185 colleges and universities.
