9 Section 2. Subsection (9) is added to section 507.07,
 10 Florida Statutes, to read:

11 507.07 Violations.—It is a violation of this chapter:

12 (9) For a mover to knowingly refuse or fail to disclose in
 13 writing to a customer before a household move that the mover or
 14 an employee of the mover who has access to the dwelling or
 15 property of the customer has been convicted of a felony listed
 16 in s. 775.21(4)(a)1. or convicted of a similar offense of

17 another jurisdiction, regardless of when such felony offense was
18 committed.

19 Section 3. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section
20 507.09, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

21 507.09 Administrative remedies; penalties.—

22 (1) The department may enter an order doing one or more of
23 the following if the department finds that a mover or moving
24 broker, or a person employed or contracted by a mover or broker,
25 has violated or is operating in violation of this chapter or the
26 rules or orders issued pursuant to this chapter:

27 (b) Imposing an administrative fine in the Class II
28 category pursuant to s. 570.971 for each act or omission.
29 However, the department must impose an administrative fine in
30 the Class IV category for each violation of s. 507.07(9) if the
31 department does not seek a civil penalty for the same offense.

32 Section 4. Subsection (2) of section 507.10, Florida
33 Statutes, is amended to read:

34 507.10 Civil penalties; remedies.—

35 (2) The department may seek a civil penalty in the Class
36 II category pursuant to s. 570.971 for each violation of this
37 chapter. However, the department must seek a civil penalty in
38 the Class IV category for each violation of s. 507.07(9) if the
39 department does not impose an administrative fine for the same
40 offense.
