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Representative Santiago offered the following:

**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Between lines 282 and 283, insert:

Section 9. The Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability shall, in consultation with the Agency for Health Care Administration and the Department of Health, develop a report analyzing the cost savings to the Medicaid program resulting from the establishment of a voluntary no-fault motor vehicle insurance option that provides coverage with no preset limit for the lifetime care of catastrophic injuries through a reinsurance model. The office shall consider any aspect of the Michigan Catastrophic Claims Association model

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14 that would be beneficial to such cost savings and consider  
 15 various rates of voluntary enrollment. The report shall also  
 16 calculate the favorable manifestation of health care jobs  
 17 related to the care, recovery, and rehabilitation of  
 18 catastrophic injuries. For purposes of this paragraph, the term  
 19 "catastrophic injuries" includes injuries to the brain or spinal  
 20 cord which result in serious and permanent disability.
