Section 2. Section 381.988, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

381.988 Tax on marijuana and marijuana products.-

(1) Notwithstanding s. 212.08, the sale of marijuana and marijuana products is subject to the sales tax imposed by

chapter 212.

(2) All moneys collected pursuant to this section shall be

deposited by the Department of Revenue within the same calendar month as the sales taxes are collected by the department.

- (a) Half of all sales tax proceeds collected shall be transferred to the Education/General Student and Other Fees Trust Fund to fund research and development, as determined by the Board of Governors of the State University System, related to the safety and efficacy of marijuana.
- (b) The remainder of the sales tax proceeds shall be deposited into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund within the Department of Children and Families to be used exclusively to fund substance abuse prevention, education, and treatment programs.
- 1. For the purposes of this paragraph, substance abuse prevention, education, and treatment programs include, but are not limited to, targeted education programs related to the abuses of licit and illicit drugs, school- and community-based prevention and intervention programs utilizing proven evidencebased practices, adolescent substance abuse treatment, treatment programs for youth and adults in the justice system, and programs designed to divert substance abusers away from the justice system.
- 2. Funds deposited into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund pursuant to this paragraph must be accounted for separately within the fund and may be transferred to other state agencies as authorized by the Legislature upon execution of an interagency memorandum of understanding specifying the purpose of the transfer, the programs to be funded, and the specific outcomes that will be achieved.
